### Class Description

Essay writing:

Students will build on the knowledge acquired in C1.1 to further develop their essay writing skills with particular emphasis on register and structure.

A variety of contemporary global/social issues will be addressed in the form of newspaper/journal articles, videos and/or podcasts and serve as the basis for the development of students' criticality, writing approach and oral proficiency.

Debates:

Based on the Oxford-Union style, students will consolidate the knowledge acquired in C1.1 to further develop their oral skills and critical awareness by participating in controlled class debates. At this more advanced level, greater emphasis will be placed on vocabulary expansion, register, more complex language structures and fluency.

Play Analysis:

Students will view a play in class for subsequent analysis with a view to writing an essay.
